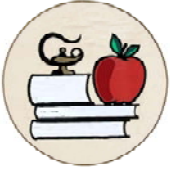

Barnegat Township Schools is purchasing Study Island, a web-based program, to help prepare our students for the state standardized tests. This program is accessible to all basic skills students from school, home or anywhere with an Internet connection.

Since the Study Island state assessment program is completely web-based, students can access it from any computer with an Internet connection and a standard web browser (Internet Explorer or Netscape). Students' study session results are recorded and made available to the teachers. This includes results from sessions completed at home.

The program is divided into sections based on subject and core curriculum content standards in math and reading, by infusing a social studies, humanities and science concept-based approach).
