The Boys' Track and Field Team had a busy weekend (April 30-May 1), as members of the team competed in the Ocean County Relay Championships, Ocean County Freshman-Sophomore Championships, and the Mercer Twilight Invitational, with outstanding performances all around.

The Boys' team took third place at the Ocean County Relays on Friday night, April 30th, and they were keyed by the Sprint Medley's first place, school-record setting performance. Brian Gautier, Tom Erb, Steve Kirkland, and Matt Nelson combined for a time of 3:38, breaking the old record by a full three seconds! The Boys also broke the school record in the 400 Hurdle Relay, the 4X100 meter relay, the 4X200 meter relay, and the 4X400 meter relay.

Great job!

Freshman Matt Nelson again made state history on Saturday night at the Mercer Twilight Invitational, setting the all time New Jersey State record for freshmen in the 5000 meters, running 15:12.24 to crush the old record by 13 seconds!!! Matt's time for 3.1 miles is an average of 4:53 per mile. Great job boys!

- ❖ Jessica Pepenella, BHS Sophomore has been awarded the Gold Award for Girl Scouts USA. This is the highest honor given by this national organization and consists of over a year's worth of program requirements and an 80 hour project. The project was subjected to committee approval both before and after the activity. Jessica worked with the Barnegat Library and presented GET READY TO ROCK KINDERGARTEN, a crash course for preschoolers and their families. This was held on March 13th with the help of 22 student volunteers (from ROBMS and BHS). Jessica created the Ocean County Library's first preschool reading list which is available on their website. Senior exams will begin on June 14th during class time in order to calculate GPA's, class ranks, and Valedictorian and Salutatorian. Senior make-ups will be held ASAP. Graduation practice will be scheduled for Grade 12 students on June 21st through 24th.

Motion to approve a Senior High School trip during 2009 – 2010 school year. The trip will be to Disney World and will include three nights accommodations in the All Star Resort, 4 – day Disney Park hopper pass with 4 add-ons, round-trip air transportation from Philadelphia to Orlando, security guards on duty during the evening hours to assist chaperones, souvenir color group photo; meals to include \$5.00 for breakfast, 3 meal coupons for dinner and a dinner at Hollywood Studios with viewing of Illuminations Show. The trip includes round-trip motor coach transportation from the high school to Philadelphia airport. The trip is scheduled for May 21 – 24, 2010. There will be 1 chaperone free for every 15 students and one administrator will be accompanying the students. Experienced tour personnel will assist chaperones during the entire stay. Cost per student based on quad occupancy is \$1,000.

Project Graduation is an all night celebration that will be offered for Barnegat High School graduating seniors. The event runs from 9:30 PM to 6 AM on June 24th, the night of commencement. Seniors who participate will return to school after the graduation ceremony and participate with a festive ride around Manhattan on the Spirit of New Jersey and enjoy dancing and good food. This will be the last time they are able to do something together as a class. In order to secure a spot, we ask that each senior who wishes to attend return the attendance slip with \$15 non-refundable sign-up fee. Further information will be provided to our seniors during graduation practices.

We will need five school buses to drive us to and from Project Graduation.

Motion to approve submission New Jersey's Plan for Round 2 for Race to the Top Key reforms for continual system learning and improvement include: Academic Standards, Assessments, Longitudinal Data Systems, the evaluation of educational impacts, stakeholder involvement, transparency and data-driven decision making, incentive systems and accountability, improved system performance and many more. New Jersey will be applying for up to \$400million as part of Round 2 of the US Department of Education's Race to the Top. Two hundred million dollars (\$200 million) of the \$400million will go directly to school districts if New Jersey is selected. A collective bargaining signature is not required in the second round. LEA signatures are required for the district including Superintendent, President of Local School Board and Local Teachers' Union Leader if applicable. CODE OF ETHICS

Board of Education

A school board member shall abide by the following Code of Ethics for School Board Members:

1. I will uphold and enforce all laws, state board rules and regulations of the State Board of Education, and court orders pertaining to schools. Desired changes shall be brought about only through legal and ethical procedures.
2. I will make decisions in terms of educational welfare of children and will seek to develop and maintain public schools that meet the individual needs of all children regardless of their ability, race, creed, sex or social standing.
3. I will confine my board action to policy making, planning, and appraisal, and I will help to frame policies and plans only after the board has consulted those who will be affected by them.
4. I will carry out my responsibility, not to administer the schools, but, together with my fellow board members, to see that they are will run.
5. I will recognize that authority rests with the board of education and will make no personal promises nor take any private action that may compromise the board.
6. I will refuse to surrender my independent judgment to special interest or partisan political groups or to use the schools for personal gain or for the gain of friends.
7. I will hold confidential all matters pertaining to the schools which, if disclosed, would needlessly injure individuals or the schools. In all other matters, I will provide accurate information and, in concert with my fellow board members, interpret to the staff the aspirations of the community for its school.
8. I will vote to appoint the best qualified personnel available after consideration of the recommendation of the chief administrative officer.
9. I will support and protect school personnel in proper performance of their duties.
10. I will refer all complaints to the chief administrative officer and will act on the complaints at public meetings only after failure of an administrative solution.
