VI. AWARDS/PRESENTATIONS:

- ◆ Congratulations to Matt Nelson, a student and standout athlete at the Russell O. Brackman Middle School, participated in USA Track and Field's Junior Olympics held in Omaha, Nebraska, in July. To qualify, Matt ran in several preliminary meets in both the 1500 and 3000 meter races, capturing the New Jersey State and Mid-Atlantic Region titles along the way. At Nationals, Matt placed 4th in the 3000 meter final and 6th in the 3000. His times for each are equivalent to 4:38 for the mile, and 10:08 for 2 miles.
- ◆ The Barnegat School District has been awarded a \$25,000 Grant for the Barnegat High School Library/Media Center from the Ocean First Foundation. The grant was developed by Karen Ray and Janna Van Velson and was entitled "Coming Together in a Shrinking World." Over 125 schools in the Ocean and Monmouth County area submitted grant proposals including our elementary and middle schools. Ten elementary schools were awarded \$10,000 each, four middle schools were awarded \$25,000 each and four High Schools \$25,000 each for a total of \$300,000 in grant awards this year alone.
- ◆ We are proud to announce that four of the Middle School's Sport's Teams were Division winners during the Fall Athletic Season. They are: the Boys and Girls Soccer teams; the Boys Cross Country team and the Girls Volleyball team.
- ◆ Congratulations! 500 lbs of food and \$297 were raised for the Barnegat Food Pantry at the BHS Homecoming. Well done!!!!

RESOLUTION OF THE BARNEGAT TOWNSHIP BOARD OF EDUCATION AUTHORIZING AND PERMITTING ON A TEMPORARY BASIS THE INSTALLATION OF WIND/WEATHER MEASURING EQUIPMENT ON BOARD PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Barnegat Township Board of Education, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey (hereinafter referred to as the "Board"), has been approached by representatives of Rowan University ("Rowan") with a request to install on a temporary basis wind/weather measuring equipment on Board property in order to determine the viability of placing alternative energy generating devices on Board property; and

WHEREAS, Rowan will provide at no cost to the Board all of the temporary installation, not to exceed one (1) year, and should also provide appropriate certificates of liability insurance insuring and holding harmless the Board from any potential damages; and

WHEREAS, the Board believes this request is appropriate and reasonable, and in the long-term best interests of the Board and the taxpayers of Barnegat Township;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this _____ day of November, 2008, by the Barnegat Township Board of Education, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Board agrees on a temporary basis, not to exceed one (1) year, that Rowan shall be permitted to install wind/weather measuring equipment on Board property (specific location to be mutually agreed upon by Board and Rowan) in order to determine the viability of placing on a permanent basis alternative energy generating devices on Board property.

2. No work shall be performed on Board property until appropriate certificates of liability insurance have been provided by Rowan to the Board, thereby indemnifying and holding harmless the Board from any future damages resulting from the installation of the equipment.

3. The Board authorizes and directs the Board President, Board Secretary, Superintendent, and Business Administrator to execute any and all necessary documents in order to implement the intent of this Resolution.

CODE OF ETHICS

Board of Education

A school board member shall abide by the following Code of Ethics for School Board Members:

1. I will uphold and enforce all laws, state board rules and regulations of the State Board of Education, and court orders pertaining to schools. Desired changes shall be brought about only through legal and ethical procedures.
2. I will make decisions in terms of educational welfare of children and will seek to develop and maintain public schools that meet the individual needs of all children regardless of their ability, race, creed, sex or social standing.
3. I will confine my board action to policy making, planning, and appraisal, and I will help to frame policies and plans only after the board has consulted those who will be affected by them.
4. I will carry out my responsibility, not to administer the schools, but, together with my fellow board members, to see that they are will run.
5. I will recognize that authority rests with the board of education and will make no personal promises nor take any private action that may compromise the board.
6. I will refuse to surrender my independent judgment to special interest or partisan political groups or to use the schools for personal gain or for the gain of friends.
7. I will hold confidential all matters pertaining to the schools which, if disclosed, would needlessly injure individuals or the schools. In all other matters, I will provide accurate information and, in concert with my fellow board members, interpret to the staff the aspirations of the community for its school.
8. I will vote to appoint the best qualified personnel available after consideration of the recommendation of the chief administrative officer.
9. I will support and protect school personnel in proper performance of their duties.
10. I will refer all complaints to the chief administrative officer and will act on the complaints at public meetings only after failure of an administrative solution.
